

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE (BTS) TEXTILE DESIGN



Aims and outcomes

Graduates with this degree create feels, colours, textures, motifs, patterns, shapes for all areas of fashion, textile and environment.

They define and communicate the trends that will develop in textiles, coverings, clothing, accessories, the car industry, cosmetics...

Training is aimed at :

- meeting the needs of the different professions as well as taking into account the constant changes in the new fields of creation ;
- providing students with the fundamental skills that will enable them to work independently or collaboratively or to progress to graduate courses.

It is meant to produce professionals as well as to develop the students' creative individuality. Courses share the same goal of providing the students with an extended cultural, artistic and professional knowledge. They aim at increasing their awareness of the contemporary artistic and design environments, of the fashion world and of current ways of life.

Course content

The textile studio trains students to go to careers in the different fields of fashion and textile. It focuses on the design and creation of products applying to environment, habitat, clothes and accessories.

It relies on profession-oriented artistic, technological and cultural training.

Studio teaching encourages creativity and innovativeness. It gives priority to tactile and visual approaches and experimentation, leading to questioning and the development of methodology and enhancing personal ways of working. Students are provided with fundamental technical skills applied to creation as they manipulate materials, set up projects, are made aware of constraints and creation processes, as well as use new technologies and professional software.

Career prospects

Depending on the students' profiles and personal projects, they can choose to :

- do a graduate degree in France or abroad in the fields of applied arts, decorative arts, art and craft design or fine arts,
- or start working independently or within a company or a trend or textile design agency.
